Steps to become a Suffolk County Volleyball official and a member of SBVO

- 1. You must complete an online training course set down by NY State (NYSCVOA), referred to as EOT. There is a \$50 fee for the EOT through the link provided: http://www.sunyocc.edu/community. Please notify both Rich Maggio (SBVO.President@gmail.com) and myself, Diane Sanciola (SBVO.Secretary@gmail.com) when you have completed the EOT.
- 2. The EOT must be completed for you to be eligible to enroll in the SBVO course. The course is \$125 and consists of zoom classes and on court instruction. There are approximately 10 classes total. Our classes usually run in August.
- 3. Once the courses are completed you will have to pass both a written exam and an on court practical.
- 4. Fingerprint clearance must be submitted.
- 5. You must purchase the required uniform and equipment.
- 6. Once your SBVO dues are paid (currently \$139), your first assignments will be for the Modified girls volleyball (November 2025 January 2026).
- 7. Please note that there is a separate on court rating and a separate dues to officiate boys volleyball. Although under the same umbrella, Boys and girls Volleyball are separate certifications.
